

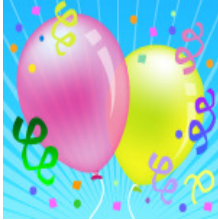

Site News

WPE/MS: WPE and MS students will be joining together on May 9th for an "End of the Year Talent Show!" Students who were interested tried out for the talent show in order for Site Coordinators to judge the appropriateness of all acts. Students have then practiced for the last few weeks to prepare for the show. The acts include singing, rapping, dancing, hula hooping, jumping rope, and several others. Middle School students will be coming down to WPE on the actual performance day.

about Earth and things they found interesting about nature. A cinquain poem is a five line poem that includes the following patterns:

Cinquain Pattern #1

Line1: One word

Line2: Two words

Line 3: Three words

Line 4: Four words

Line 5: One word

Cinquain Pattern #2

Line 1: A Noun

Line 2: 2 Adjectives

Line 3: 3-ing words

Line 4: A 4 word phrase

Line 5: Another noun

Students then discussed why it is important to think about the Earth and to use resources wisely.

2012-2013 BASE Program
