- Review and Update the District Wellness Program
 - Mr. Orchard presented to the board an update on the district wellness program.

- Approval of Cash Basis accounting method beginning 7/1/24 (CSIP S7 AP1 & AP2) -(Approved 6-0).
- MSBA Policy Update
 - MSBA recommends rescinding policy IGDJA-R since it can not be reflected in our online manual. The policy code is no longer available due to its age and being unused - (Approved 6-0 to rescind).
- Approval of joining "BuyBoard" National Purchasing Cooperative (CSIP S7 AP1)

 The BuyBoard National Purchasing Cooperative is a cooperative formed by governmental agencies to streamline the buying process for public schools and other government agencies; the City of West Plains is currently a partner in this program - (Approved 6-0).

- Federal Programs and Special Education Report (CSIP S7 AP 1 & 3) Dr. Davis
- Superintendent's Report (CSIP S1 AP 1; S3 AP1 & AP2; S5 AP 2 & AP3) Dr. Davis
 - Dr. Davis spoke about the need to replace our existing dishwashers at WPES and WPHS and the current status of the scoreboard at Zizzer Stadium. All of these will need to be replaced soon.
 - He reported that over \$53,000 of tuition funds have been reimbursed to current teachers working on their masters. This was all made possible by a grant the district received.
 - He also noted that over \$50,000 in the Lease Purchase funds from 2019 had not been "drawn down" by the district. Dr. Davis said these funds will have to be expended on facilities improvements.
 - He discussed the possibilities of baseball/softball field upgrades and the East Wing/WPHS connection idea. The board asked him to pursue cost estimates for both projects and report back in the upcoming months. Also, he was asked to look at a future gym/performing arts facility. Dr. Davis explained that a gym/performing arts facility project would need increased funding, which would take the people's vote, as the district does not have the funds to do that.
 - Updated information on school conference affiliation was also presented. Several different school districts are in the process of shifting to different conferences and also looking at making new ones. Dr. Davis told the board that his number one priority in these conference discussions is to keep West Plains "a part" of a conference, attempt to create more opportunities for the middle school students to compete in the conference, and most importantly, not let the district become independent.
 - Lastly, he shared info on the tuition calculation and how that was progressing and enrollment and attendance data.
